

# Mounting instructions for masonry walls

## 01 Wall Shelf

### MOUNTING:

1. Using a spirit level and a pencil, draw an approx. 80 cm line on the wall where you plan to hang the shelf.
2. Mark the middle of the line with a pencil. From this point, measure 35 cm to the left and to the right, marking these spots. The two marks indicate the distance between the two holes, 70 cm.
3. Using a 10-mm bit, drill two approx. 8-cm-deep holes into the wall.
4. Insert wall anchors in the holes and carefully tap them into place using a hammer.
5. Place a washer on each shelf support.
6. Screw both shelf supports into the wall anchors using a 10 mm-wrench until the thread has completely disappeared into the wall and the washer is tight against the wall.
7. Place the shelf onto the shelf supports.

### OUR TIP:

**Get a second person to help you hang the shelf.**

### PLEASE NOTE:

**The full load-bearing capacity of the shelf can only be met if it is securely and correctly attached to the wall.**

Spirit level  
Pencil  
Drill  
10 mm-Drill bit  
(please select an appropriate drill bit for your wall material)
