

# Mounting instructions

## 02 Picture Ledge

### PLEASE NOTE:

The picture ledges are intended for mounting on masonry walls using wall anchors and screws which are included in the delivery. When hanging the picture ledge on walls made of lightweight materials (drywall or similar), anchors which are suitable for the wall material must be used – these are NOT included. Some types of wallboard do not require the use of wall anchors.

### MOUNTING:

1. Using a spirit level and a pencil, draw an approx. 40 cm (Size S) or 80 cm (Size M and Size L) line on the wall where you plan to hang the picture ledge.
2. For masonry walls: Using a 6-mm bit, drill two approx. 4-cm-deep holes into the wall, spaced 30 cm (Size S) or 70 cm (Size M and Size L) apart.  
For drywall, etc.: If necessary, screw in two wall anchors spaced 30 cm (Size S) or 70 cm (Size M and Size L) apart.
3. For masonry walls: Insert wall anchors into the holes and carefully tap them into place using a hammer.
4. Place a screw into each anchor and tighten it with a screwdriver until about 1 cm is still visible.
5. Using the holes in the picture ledge, hang it onto the screws. If the wall is uneven, you may have to tighten or loosen the screws until the ledge fits snugly against the the wall on both sides.

### OUR TIP:

Get a second person to help you hang the picture ledge.

### PLEASE NOTE:

The full load-bearing capacity of the picture ledge can only be met if it is securely and correctly attached to the wall.
